The Royal Australian Navy Band is a prestigious ceremonial unit of the Australian Defence Force, and is *one of Australia's premier military ensembles*.

The band is led by its Director of Music, Lieutenant Commander Phillip Anderson. The permanent detachments are stationed at the naval establishments HMAS *Kuttabul*, Potts Point, New South Wales and HMAS *Cerberus*, Western Port, Victoria.

To assist in fulfilling its mission, 'promote the Royal Australian Navy', the band incorporates a fleet of ensembles. All members of the band perform in a ceremonial capacity. However, to ensure versatility and to continue its public relations support for the Royal Australian Navy, each detachment maintains other capabilities including wind orchestra, wind chamber ensembles, popular music combinations as well as a sea deployment group which operates on a rotational basis.
